

Martin Library/Audubon Society Birds of My Backyard Art Contest

Submission Guidelines

York County Libraries and the Pennsylvania Audubon Society are teaming up for an art contest! We're accepting drawings and paintings that celebrate the unique biodiversity of York County - and demonstrate your personal connection with nature. What birds do you see in your backyards, and what do they mean to you and your communities?

Eligibility Requirements – Limit one entry per individual

1. Entrants may submit one original piece of art. You may enter only once.
2. Art must be the work of individuals. No collaborative efforts will be allowed.
3. Art must be delivered to Martin Library, and will be accepted only between Monday, November 16, 2009 and Saturday, January 23, 2010.
4. Each entry must:
 - a. Be original, hand-produced, flat works of art. No electronic reproductions, tracings, or computer-generated materials;
 - b. Be a minimum size of 8.5x11" to a maximum size of 11x15"
 - c. Have birds and/or nature as the primary subject.
5. Each entry submitted must have the following information attached:
 - a. Entrant's Name
 - b. Parent's Name
 - c. Phone Number With Area Code
 - d. Current Grade
 - e. Name of School

Art entered without proper identification will be disqualified!

6. Entry categories are as follows:
 - a. Grades 1-3
 - b. Grades 4-6
 - c. Grades 7-9
 - d. Grades 10-12
7. There will be a first, second, and third place winner in each category.
8. Art will be judged by a panel of independent judges no later than four weeks after the deadline, and winners will be contacted directly. All winners will be contacted no later than February 27, 2010.
9. All winning art will be displayed at "A Celebration of Poetry and Art" at Martin Library on March 25, 2010.
