Stop in and color at the Library on Tuesdays from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m.



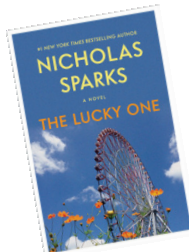
### Cook Book Club
