- Left out of the driveway onto Constitution Ave.
- At stop sign, left onto Main Street (Rt. 851) in New Freedom
- At top of hill, Main Street will continue straight and the main road will curve to the left. St. John's church is at this curve.
- Stay straight on Main Street, then left into the church's parking lot.
