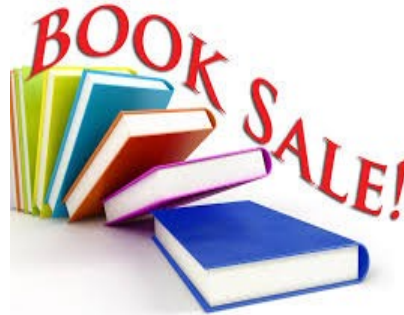
General Information
