- 5. How many people do you meet in heaven according to Mitch Albom?
- 6. Which Stephen King novel features a car as a main character?
- 7. What book was on the New York Times Best Seller list the longest in 2020?
- 8. Who reads the audiobook version of *Barbara Kingsolver's* **Prodigal Summer**?
- 9. Which book won the Pulitzer Prize for Fiction in 2020?
- 10. Which famous *Dickens* character is most like Dickens himself?
- 11. From what Pittsburgh, PA University did *Rachel Carson*, author of **Silent Spring**, graduate?
- 12. What is the title of the 2021 One Book One Community (OBOC) Selection?*
- 13. <u>The Handmaid's Tale and Testament</u> by *Atwood* are examples of what kind of fiction?
- 14. Who is the most recent American to win the Nobel prize for literature?
- 15. What is the name of *Agatha Christie's* most famous female detective?
