June is here and summer arrives on the 21st. With summer comes SummerQuest, so the library is loading up on related activities. Read on for all the latest news and announcements.

Important Covid News. As of June 1, the library will be taking significant steps in the reopening process. Our operating hours (see sidebar) return to pre-covid normal. Chairs and tables are coming back. The quarantine process for returned library items is no longer in effect, so you can return those items at the circulation desk. The 4-week covid circulation period for books returns to three weeks. In short, we are taking significant steps towards the new normal. Come in to see the latest developments.

SummerQuest. It starts June 1 and the calendar is full of events, both virtual and in-person. June's Dillsburg events are listed on page 2. An extra page three has been added which includes the Dillsburg schedule for the entire summer.

Fiddle Concert with Lampyridae! June 4, 6:00 PM—7:30 PM. The Dillsburg Area Public Library presents a concert by original works fiddle trio Lampyridae! Lampyridae has been performing together since 2019 and is composed of Dillsburg native Stuart Ryerse, Giulia Haible, and Caroline Dressler. The trio's sound combines elements of traditional Celtic fiddle music, classical training, counterpoint, and odd-metered rhythms to create an experience that is at once scintillating, exciting, and beautiful. Being comprised of multi-instrumentalists, Lampyridae is uniquely versatile in their instrumentation, and they can often be seen switching instruments seamlessly in the middle of their tunes.
