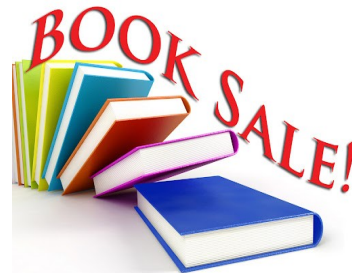
General Information
