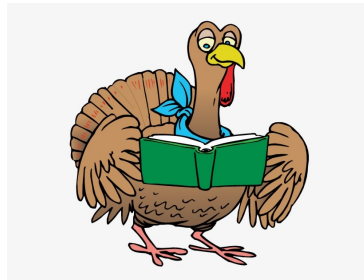
General Information
