Gen. Joshua Lawrence Chamberlain Visit Wed., Nov. 20 at 6:30pm

The hero of Little Round Top at the Battle of Gettysburg, General Chamberlain, will be our guest speaker at Red Land Community Library.

All are welcome this evening, as the General will speak in "first person" of his life and exploits, dressed in full Civil War Union Army uniform. Gen. Chamberlain won the Medal of Honor, and in later life was Governor of Maine, and the President of Bowdoin College.



Rev. Bob Macfarlane is a retired Ordained Minister in the United Church of Christ, and has been a Civil War buff and amateur historian for many years. He has performed across the country, as General Joshua Lawrence Chamberlain, to schools, churches, Civil War Roundtables, and groups like ours here at the Library. After his presentation, there will be opportunity for some questions and answers. Come and bring a friend!
