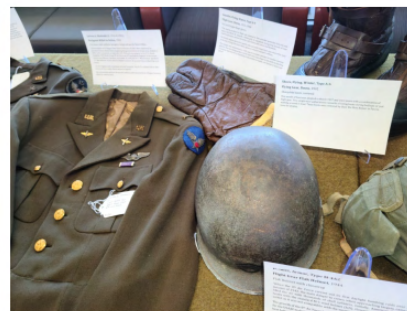

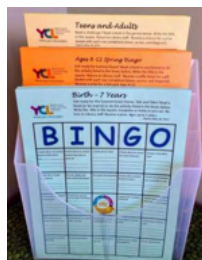

Lots to celebrate in June

- The new hours beginning in June 2021 are listed on the front of the newsletter.
