Stop by to see the display from Vietnam Veterans in the library during the month of May.

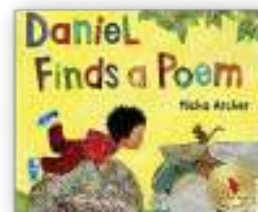
Watch for the YCL Library Van in the Etters Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 30.
