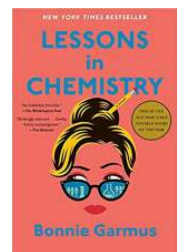

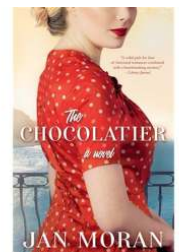


## Chocolate, continued
