Michael Maloney is a native of York County and currently resides in Red Lion. Although he grew up in York, his parents and many relatives are from Marietta in Lancaster County. Consequently, he spent many summers along the river at his grandparents' house, exploring the river and the surrounding hills. After finding out about a gravesite behind the Accomac Inn, his curiosity led him to research the history of Marietta and Accomac, looking for the story of John Coyle, Jr. His natural curiosity and love of history was the inspiration for writing the history of the area and the story of the murder of Emily Myers on Memorial Day, 1881. Across the River, Murder at Accomac is Michael's first historical book, first published in May 2012 in celebration of the 200th anniversary of Marietta. He is currently working on a second local history book about the life of Thomas Cresap.

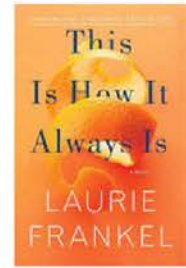
