THE BARBARA A. EISENHART HONORS EVENT

Guthrie Memorial Library has had the distinct pleasure of being the recipient of Barbara's strong support for many years. As a member of the Library's Board of Governors since 1986, she has been a constant advocate for the library in the Hanover community. She currently serves as President of the Board and was also past President of the Friends of the Library. In addition, she served as Chair of the Library's Centennial Committee in 2011 and was Hanover's representative to the York County Library System 1988-1994. She is a member of the Library's Aristotle Society and serves as Secretary of the Hanover Public Library Association, Inc.

Barbara graduated from Spring Grove High School as Valedictorian in 1967, received a B.S. in Secondary Education (French and English) from Shippensburg University in 1971, spent her Junior Year abroad at the Université de Montpellier, Southern France 1969-1970, and received a Master of Arts Degree in French from Middlebury College, Vermont in 1978.

In addition to Barbara's dedication to our library, she also served on the Board of Directors of the YWCA of Hanover from 1987-1992, acting as President of the Board 1989-1990. Her volunteer efforts also include Board of Directors of the Visiting Nurse Association 1986-1992, the Women's Auxiliary of York College of PA 1992-2003 (President 1995-1996), York Foundation's Distribution and Grant Resources Committee, Hanover Area Writers' Group, and Hanover Area Historical Society Fundraising Committee.

Barbara and her husband S. Forry Eisenhart, Jr. have three children and four grandchildren. Barbara loves reading, writing, cooking, playing the piano, and visiting art museums.
