Rental fee is \$20 for a four-week checkout (fee and checkout time may change in the future). No holds, no renewals, and each unit is sanitized upon return. Over-dues are \$2 per day. The "new normal" that has re-defined everyone's lives means that our biggest annual fundraising activities of 2020— Summer Solstice, Friends Book Sale, Mini Golf, and other fundraising events — had to be indefinitely postponed or canceled. Last year, we lost over \$100,000 of annual fundraising.

Community members use our resources for education, career support, entertainment, and engagement.

Examples of our library's impact:

- From online resources that help young students with research papers and projects, to job preparation exams and tutorials for those ready to enter the workforce, cardholders are able to utilize these sources from the comfort of their own home.
- We offer programs for children that boost their creativity and interaction, such as Story Times from birth and up and Craft Programs. We have modified these programs by creating Digital Story Times, interactive Zoom Story Times, and take-home craft activities.
- With the growing need of technology use, our library has introduced wireless Hot Spots available for rent while still providing in-library computer use, printing, and scanning services.
- We keep our collection current with the newest best-selling books, e-books, audiobooks, music, movies and more!

Guthrie Memorial Library is the heart of our community, providing inspiration, connection and information for children, adults, families, and seniors. Our programs and resources are expanding every day, but public funding has not kept up. During the pandemic, the library has provided a large menu of virtual programs, ranging from story times to book clubs, to trivia nights and more. Costs associated with this "virtual library" combined with the loss of on-site revenues including room rentals, fines and printing/copying during the COVID-19 pandemic, placed financial strain on our already tight budget. Your gift to the library — of any amount — is critical to helping us maintain the important programs and services we offer to all residents of all ages.

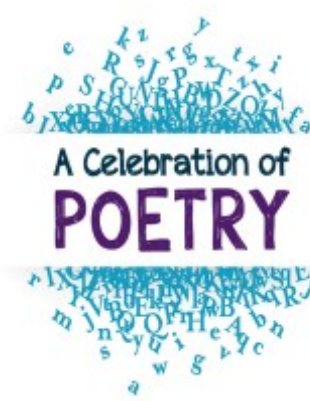

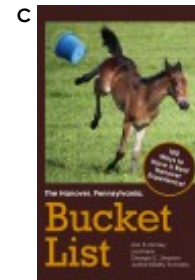

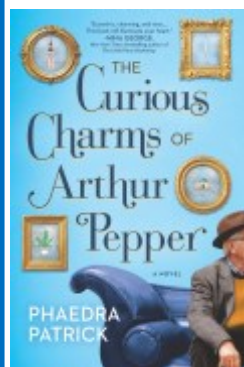
