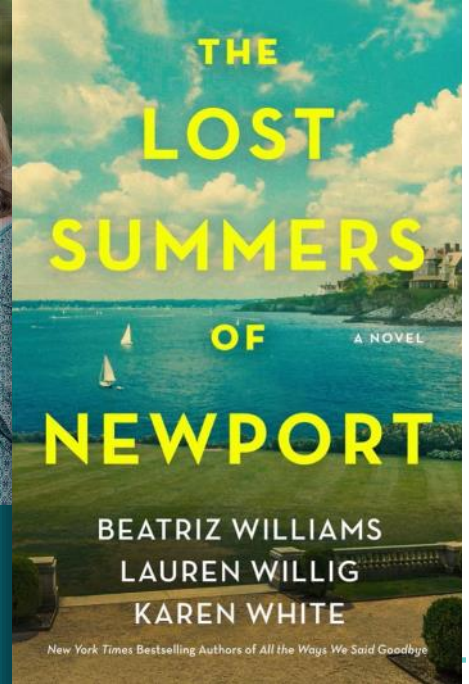

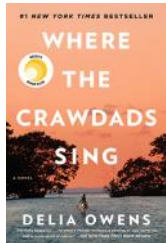

The Centralia Mining Disaster with Author David DeKok

Centralia was a pleasant community of about 1,435 in 1962. On May 27 of that year, a fire was set in Centralia's garbage dump by firemen hired by the borough council. The firemen burned the trash, and then hosed down the smoldering ashes. But something went wrong and the fire found its way into

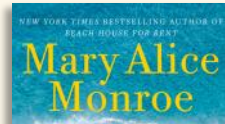
