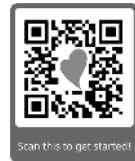
What is SummerQuest? It's library events, story times, crafts, GO York! hikes and more — FREE!

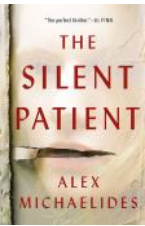

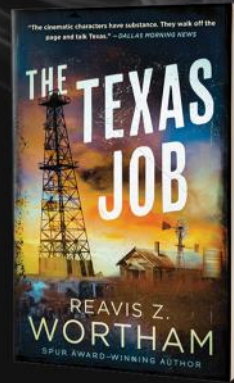
