

Helpful Tips and Information You Need to Know

You already know you can get your favorite books, movies, magazines, and other media at Guthrie Memorial Library, but

did you know:

- **You can access your library account online?** From any device with internet access, go to yorklibraries.org/hanover-guthrie. In the upper right corner, click on My Account. Log in by entering your entire library barcode number and your pin number (the last 4 digits of the barcode repeated). While in your account, you can renew your checked-out items and even place materials on hold!
- **You can call during business hours and renew your books over the phone?** That's right...just call us at **717-632-5183**. It's as easy as that!
- **The last 4 digits of your library card number are your pin?**
- **You can research your family history using our Ancestry: Library Edition database or FamilySearch from our public computers?** Ask a staff member if you have questions!
- **You can get email updates from Guthrie Memorial Library?** Stay in the know about what's happening at your library! Sign-up to receive emails about updates to stay informed: yorklibraries.org/newsletters/
- **Bike locks are available for check out while you are at the library?** Save some gas, help the planet, and keep your bike safe!
- **Charging cables are available for your cell phones and tablets?** Don't worry about your devices running low. Charging cables are now available for **in-library use** at the adult desk. The chargers have three ends: Micro USB, Lightning, USB Type C as well as a plug-in USB wall adapter. Sorry, cables cannot be checked out of the library. They are available as a courtesy for patrons' use while visiting the library.
- **We have online resources for all ages?** These include job resources, newspaper and photo archives, book recommendations, genealogical records, and much more! To access visit: yorklibraries.org/online-resources
