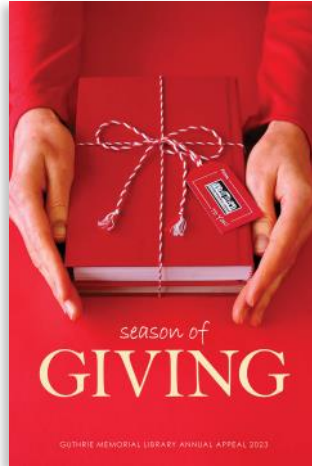

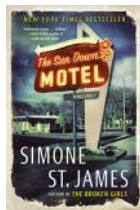

Audrey Clare Farley

is a local writer, editor, and scholar of 20th-century American culture. She teaches U.S. history at Mount St. Mary's University and creative nonfiction writing for Narratively. She lives in Hanover.

Her first book, *The Unfit*

Heiress: The Tragic Life and Scandalous Sterilization of Ann Cooper Hewitt

tells the true story of a 1930s millionairess

whose mother secretly sterilized her to deprive her of the family fortune, sparking a sensational case and forcing a debate of eugenics.

Her second book, *Girls and Their Monsters: The Genain Quadruplets and the Making of Madness in America*, explores the lives of the four women behind the National Institute of Mental Health's famous case study of schizophrenia. It was named a Michigan Notable Book and a *New York Times* Editors' Pick.

Farley's essays have appeared in *The Atlantic*, *New York Times*, *Washington Post*, and many other outlets.
