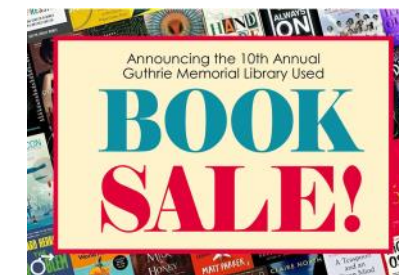


Clean Out Your Closet for a Good Cause

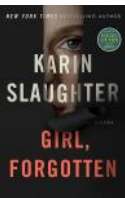
