


# 1000 Books Before Kindergarten

On Thursday, November 1st @ 6:00 pm Kristin Varner from the RASE Project will be presenting **Opioid 101 training** for all interested members of our Kreutz Creek community, providing a better understanding of addiction, its effects, and the process of recovery. The training will look at the risk factors that lead someone to develop a Substance Use Disorder, the difficulties in breaking the addiction cycle and the treatment options available.

On Tuesday, November 20th @ 6:00 pm Robert Willis, BA of York/Adams Drug and Alcohol Commission will present **Narcan training** on how to recognize overdose symptoms, how to use Narcan nasal spray, and how to find available treatment options.
