How the Five Literacies Weave Together

As we work towards gaining Silver Star status in the PA Forward Star Library Program, this month we are offering programs that focus on an aspect of Health Literacy. On February 3rd, we present the opportunity for you to determine your level of awareness about your own eye health. Two graduate students from Elizabethtown College's Physician Assistant Program will conduct preand post-program assessments to evaluate whether attendees will make changes to their screen time habits based on the educational information provided.

We develop the theme of eye health on February 22nd, when we welcome Kelly Ford, an Environmental Education Specialist with the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources as she shares information about the total solar eclipse, which will be visible in North America on April 8th, 2024. Kelly will explain what to expect and how to safely view this rare event. Previously I have shown how programming at Kreutz Creek Library relates to one of the PA Forward Five Literacies (Basic, Information, Civic & Social, Health, Financial). In real terms, our programming usually contains elements of more than one literacy. While both events mentioned above focus on providing health information, enabling our community members to actively manage their own and their family's well-being, making them effective partners with their health care providers and thereby reducing costs, the events are both group activities, giving citizens access to the knowledge and skills they need to improve their lives and thus constitute Civic & Social Literacy.
