

HEALTH LITERACY

The PA Forward initiative is designed to equip Pennsylvanians with the knowledge and resources they need to make better choices to improve their lives and the lives of those around them. When those decisions involve hard choices, sometimes it is a struggle to keep on track. At Kreutz Creek Library, we aim to bring you information about some of those difficult topics that we hope will help you make good decisions.

On April 11th, we welcome back Trove Street® for a Health Literacy program to discover an effortless way to make choices that prioritize your health. Pam Myers, co-founder FULLforLife, will walk you through strategies to promote emotional wellness as a pathway to vibrant living. Do not be put off by the title of her seminar: Break Free from Emotional Eating is about more than just ditching the diet mentality or curbing the cravings.
