Sunday, Sept. 24 from 12-3pm

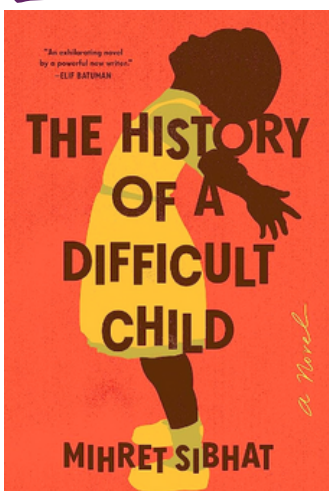
