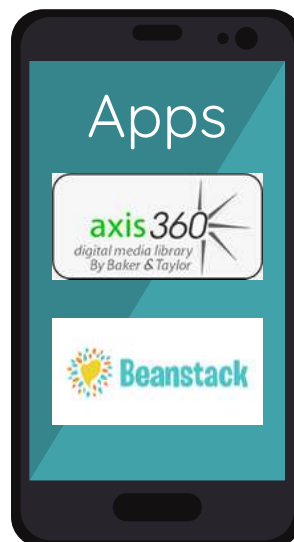

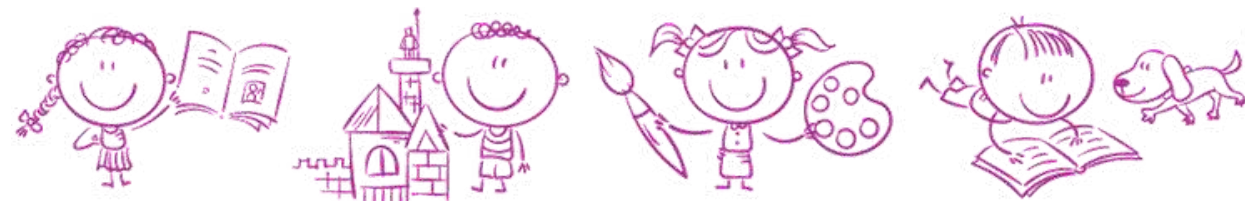

Due to Youth Services staffing changes, we will be in transition mode and there will be some adjustments to morning story sessions. Siblings are still welcome at either session.

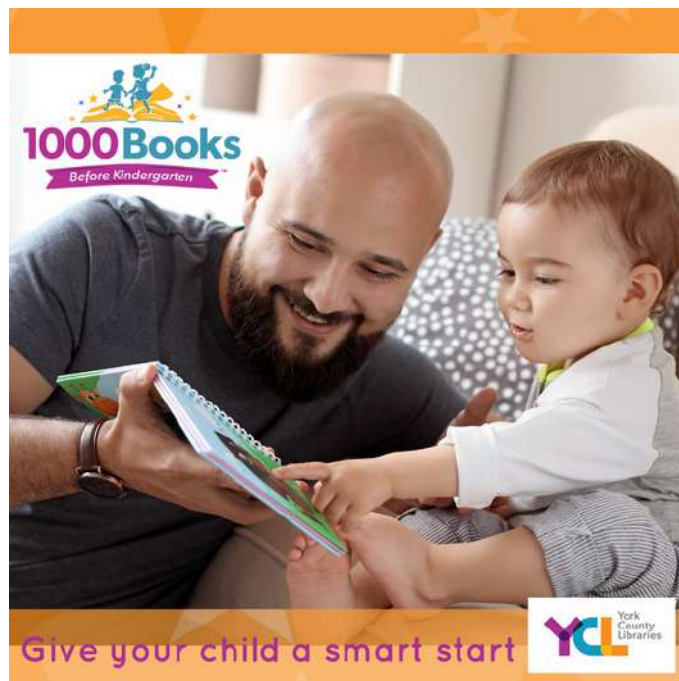
Preschool Story Time: Tuesday mornings at 10 am Ages 4 and 5

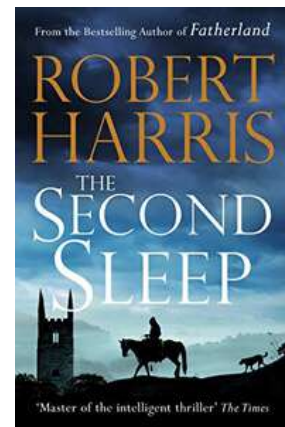
Windy Hill Book Club

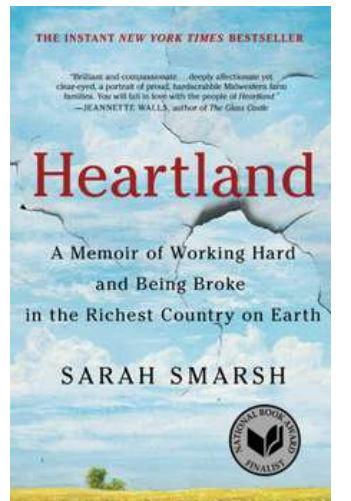
FEATURED NEW BOOK
