LIBRARY UPDATES

York County Libraries will expand
In-library services and hours at several
locations starting Tuesday, June 1.
The libraries will shift from their current
browse and go model to one that can
accommodate members who want to
stay longer.

There are two exceptions:
Kreutz Creek Library in Hellam
Martin Library in York will not add
seating and computers.
Both are due to current renovation and
construction projects.

Collections & Borrowing

The process for picking up hold items
returns to normal. Items placed on hold
can be picked up at library circulation
desks.

The borrowing period for books and
audiobooks reverts to three weeks
Beginning June 1.
Wait time for holds will be reduced as
library items will no longer be
quarantined between borrowers.
Books can be returned at most library
circulation desks and book drops.
High touch items including magazines
and children's board books will be
available to borrow.

Furniture for seating will be added back.

Indoor library programs may resume.
SummerQuest programs will be held
virtually and outdoors if planned.
YCL is following the guidelines of the
Office of Commonwealth Libraries.

Masks will be required at all facilities.
