PHASE 1A

- Healthcare and EMS workers
- Residents & staff of long-term care facility residents
- People age 65 & older
- Persons ages 16-64 with high-risk conditions: Cancer, Chronic kidney disease, COPD, Down Syndrome, Heart conditions, Immunocompromised state, Obesity, Severe Obesity, Pregnancy, Sickle cell disease, Smoking, Type 2 diabetes mellitus

PHASE 1B

- Persons receiving home & community based services
- First responders
- Correctional officers
- Food and agricultural workers
- USPS workers
- Manufacturing workers
- Grocery store workers
- Education workers
- Clergy & support for houses of worship
- Public transit workers
- Individuals caring for children/adults in early day programs



PHASE 1C

- Essential workers (Transportation & logistics, Water & wastewater, Food service, Housing construction, Finance, Information technology, Communications, Energy, Legal services, Government workers, Media, Public safety, Public health workers)



PHASE 2

- Anyone (16 and older and no contraindication to the vaccine) who wants vaccinated

Vaccinations are phased based on COVID-19 exposure risk and aligned with vaccine supply

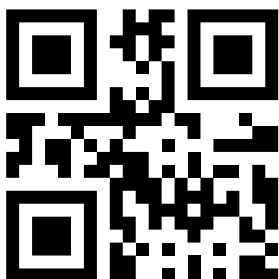
