




Using Libby on a Fire Tablet

Amazon Fire users can install Libby using our APK (Android Package file), since Amazon has not yet added the Libby app to the Amazon Appstore.

Note: The Libby APK is supported on Fire tablets with Fire OS 5+.

On your Fire tablet, open this link in the Silk Browser (overdrive.com/apps/libby/kindlefire) and click on the **download link for the Libby APK** under Step 1.

On your Fire tablet, open the Silk Browser and visit the [download link for the Libby APK](#).  **Click here after opening the link!**

You may get warnings saying that the Silk browser needs more access on your device or that this kind of file should be avoided. Overdrive tests its files to make sure it's safe, so you can safely dismiss these messages for the Libby APK.

Tap **OK**, **Allow**, or **Continue** to proceed. (The wording of the warnings may vary.)

Your tablet and personal data are more vulnerable to attack by unknown apps. By installing this app, you agree that you are responsible for any damage to your tablet or loss of data that may result from its use.

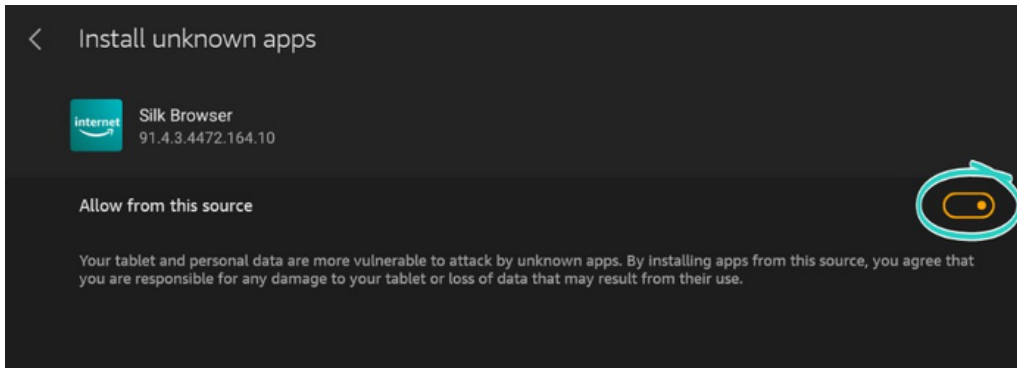

Once the file downloads, tap Open. (If you're unable to open the file from this prompt, locate the file in your downloads folder and tap to open.)

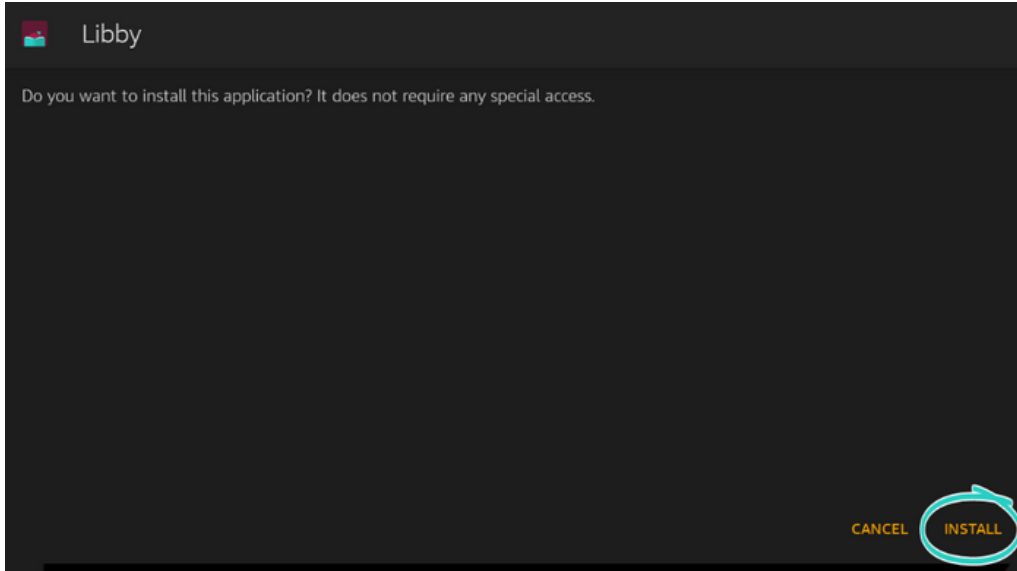
If you get a message saying your device is not allowed to install unknown apps from this source, tap **Settings** and toggle “Allow from this source” **on**.



Note: We recommend turning this setting off after installing the Libby app. This will prevent you from accidentally downloading unsafe files in the future.

Tap the **back** button in the top-left corner, then tap **Install**.

Once the app is finished installing, tap **Open** to start using Libby.
