# SUE AND DAN FREY HONORS EVENT

It is with great joy that the Honors Committee of Guthrie Memorial Library announces its sixth annual Honors event, honoring Sue and Dan Frey. Sue was born in Chicago and grew up in Wilmette, Illinois. She graduated from Dickinson College and married her college sweetheart. They began traveling the world together, moving nine times in four years.

Dan was born in Hanover and grew up on Baer Avenue, attended St. Joseph School, spent two years at Delone, and graduated from St. Francis Prep in 1963. After a year at Kings College, Dan transferred to Dickinson College graduating in 1967. Dan continued his education at John Marshall Law School in Chicago, graduating in 1970. He then spent four wonderful and challenging years in the U.S. Marine Corps, as a prosecuting attorney and military judge, reaching the rank of Captain.
