Please check the library catalog before recommending a title for purchase. Please be aware that we generally do not order items for our collection more than two months ahead of the publication date.

Recommend a Purchase

Are there limits to how many titles I can recommend?

You can recommend up to two titles per month for all formats of material.

Will you automatically buy my recommended title?

We will make every effort to accommodate your request, but we cannot guarantee we will be able to purchase the materials you request. Priority is given to recommendations that are currently, or soon to be, published

Due to the volume of requests, we are unable to contact you with the status of the request or place a hold on the item for you if we do purchase it. Please check the catalog at a later time to see if your request has been purchased.

If the decision is made to not purchase the material, as long as it has not been released within the last 12 months, we will try to borrow it for you through Interlibrary Loan.
