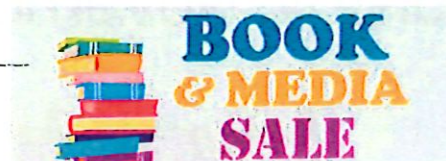

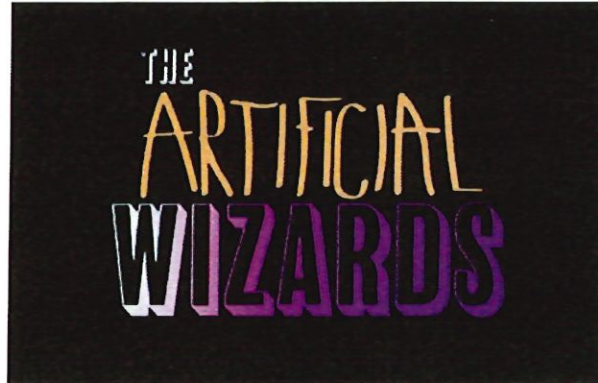
Adult Programs
