Tony was born and raised in York County, planting his roots deeply into the area. Graduating from York College in 1976, he married his wife, Stef. They are proud parents of three sons: Jason, Tony, and Ryan; and grandparents to six amazing grandchildren: Nathan, Aidan, Maddie, Ruby, Lyla, and Cora.

Tony holds a CPCU Designation, a BS in Accounting and Finance from York College of PA and is a graduate of the Insurance Agency Management Program of the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School.

Tony currently serves as Chairman of the Glatfelter Insurance Group. Since joining the Glatfelter Organization in 1980, Tony has served as VP Finance/CFO; the Executive VP Operations; and as President/CEO. In addition to his work, Tony is actively involved in numerous community organizations, including Better York, Crispus Attucks Association, United Way of York County, Penn-Mar Human Services, Salvation Army, York Habitat for Humanity, York County Literacy Council, and York College.
