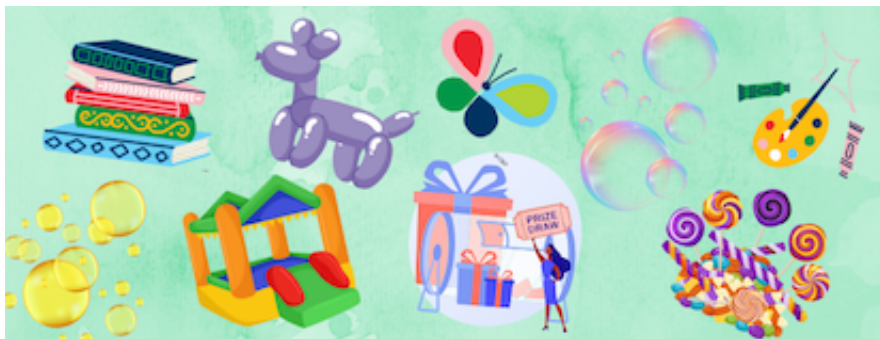

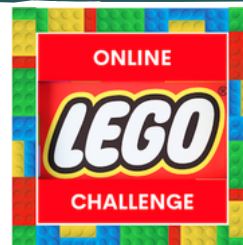

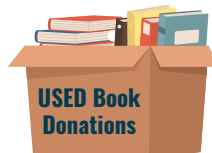
**The Friends Corner**
