

To meet this challenge, YCL has launched a new initiative, Literacy for Change, a 24-hour online peer-to-peer fundraising and advocacy effort to support the library services happening behind the scenes that benefit the whole county, such as the vans that deliver materials to all library locations and free Wi-Fi in all library buildings.
