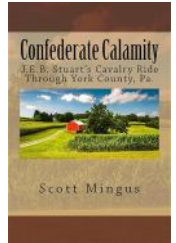


Jeb Stuart's Ride from Hanover to Carlisle with Scott Mingus

Jeb Stuart's ride is detailed in Scott Mingus's work "Confederate Calamity: J.E.B. Stuart's Cavalry Ride Through York County, Pa.", which describes Stuart's journey after the

Battle of Hanover on June 30, 1863. The route was a disorganized march through York County, during which Stuart's troops took supplies, horses, and mules from local farms. He was trying to reach the main Confederate army in PA after his plans were disrupted by Union forces.

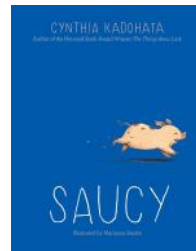

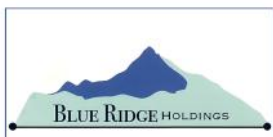
