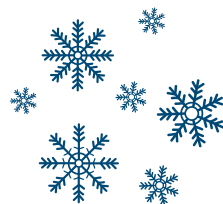

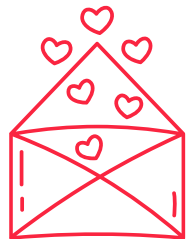
February is for Book Lovers!

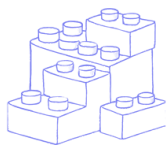
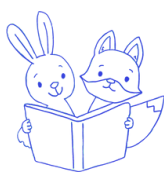

Coding Club: February 19 at 6:00pm (Third Thursday of the Month)

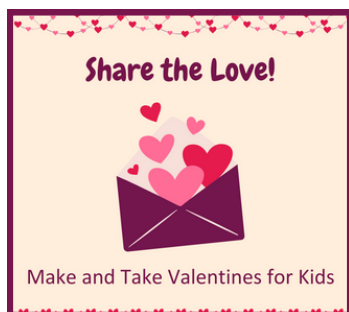

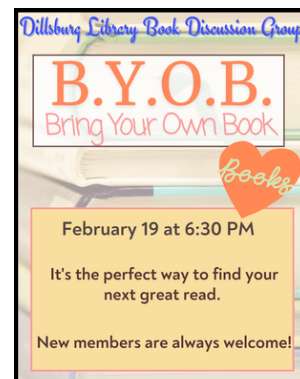
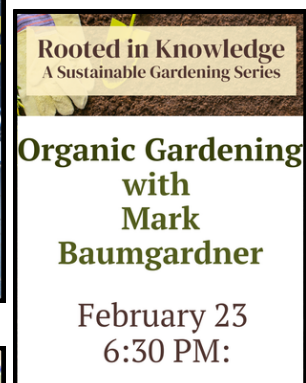


Raised Garden Coming to Our Library Thanks to Local Scout!
