While We've Been Closed

Guthrie Memorial Library has been closed to the public for nearly two months after a pipe burst and caused some significant water damage to the building. As soon as we realized that this would not be a quick fix, staff began working to set up a *library alternative* to help our patrons in the meantime. **Thus, the Library-in-the-Lobby was born:**

While we remain closed, our lobby is open and ready for you to visit. Two staff members are stationed in the lobby to check out your holds, retrieve any available books you want, and assist you with any of your information needs. While patrons are unable to browse the full library collection, we've brought some of the collection to you!
