UNCOVERING "CHEAPSIDE"

The Third Wednesday Evening of Community Programming will uncover Revolutionary War Officer James Patterson's "Cheapside": A Late 18th Century Log Farmhouse in Hopewell Township, PA, presented by Dr. Donald W. Linebaugh.

Dr. Linebaugh is professor of Historic Preservation in the School of Architecture, Planning, and Preservation at the University of Maryland College Park. Utilizing a forensic architectural approach, Dr. Linebaugh will discuss the property's history and the evolution of the 2-story, log farmhouse built by Officer Patterson in the 1780's and lived until his death in the late 1830's. In the year of our country's 250th anniversary, come learn about some local history.
