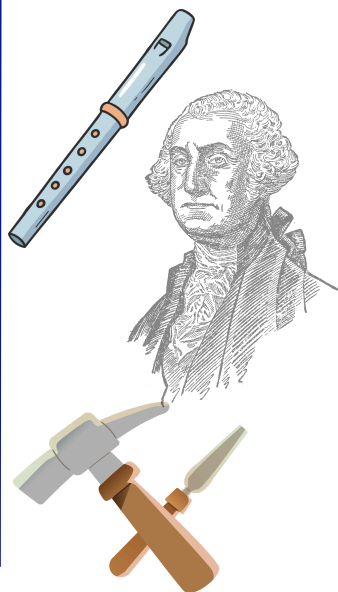
July 2026 Highlights!

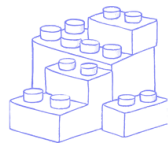
