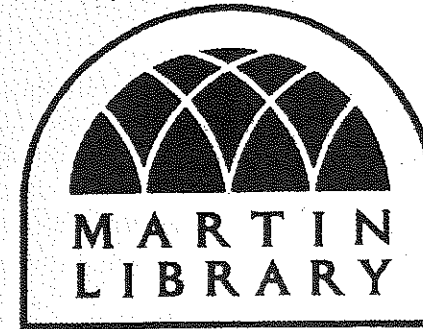

Remembering today...

*Otis B. Morse IV
birth - June 2, 1920
death - February 27, 1996*

Otis Morse was born in York, the son of Frances Sheely and Otis B. Morse III. He was a graduate of William Penn Senior High School and the American Academy of Dramatic Arts, and attended Columbia and New York Universities. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II. As a member of the First Presbyterian Church he was a Sunday school teacher and an Elder for many years.

As a founder of WSBA Radio and WSBA TV, he served as news director, and was program director of WOYK Radio.

He was chairman of the Pennsylvania State Democratic Committee and served as administrative secretary for Governors George Leader and David Lawrence.

He was the chief executive officer of Marketechs of York.

He was a member of the Board of Directors of the YMCA, York Day Nursery, Memorial Hospital and the York County Industrial Corporation. He developed a non-smoking clinic for the American Lung Association. He served on the Penn State York Advisory Board for 15 years. He was a volunteer at Martin Library.

Members of his family include his wife, Midge L. Morse; son, Otis B. Morse V; daughters, Rebecca and Emily; and five grandchildren who join us here today.
